Describing and understanding the social, demographic and economic characteristics is a key first step in addressing health inequalities.

SOCIODEMOGRAPHIC CHARACTERISTICS

The Nunavik population is characterized by its **HIGH PROPORTION OF YOUNG ADULTS**.



Half of Nunavimmiut aged 16 years and over (53%) were in a **RELATIONSHIP**, while 42% were **SINGLE**.

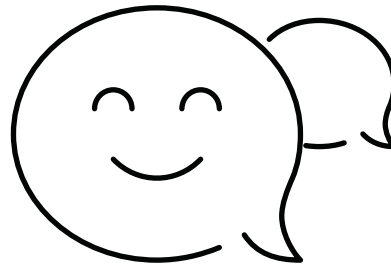


44% **16 to 30 years old**
39% **31 to 54 years old**
17% **55 years and over**



LANGUAGES

9 out of 10 of Nunavimmiut reported **SPAKING INUKTITUT WITHOUT DIFFICULTY OR FAIRLY WELL (91%)**.



3 out of 4 Nunavimmiut reported speaking (73%) and reading (77%) **ENGLISH OR FRENCH WITHOUT DIFFICULTY OR FAIRLY WELL**.

SOCIOECONOMIC CHARACTERISTICS

More people reported having **ATTENDED SECONDARY SCHOOL** in 2017 compared to 2004 (61% vs. 56%).

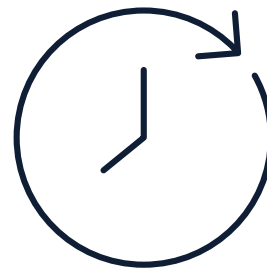


61% of Nunavimmiut have **ATTENDED A VOCATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAM** (carpentry, cooking, jewelry, heavy equipment, training on the job).



84% of Nunavimmiut participated in **PAID WORK** (including self-employment) and 42% in **UNPAID WORK** (childcare, volunteering).

45% of Nunavimmiut were **EMPLOYED FULL-TIME** at the time of the survey.



46% of Nunavimmiut reported an **ANNUAL INCOME BELOW \$20 000**. This is similar to 2004.

52% reported **NOT HAVING ENOUGH MONEY** to meet their needs.

Regional organizations are committed to working with the communities to improve the living conditions contributing to the health and wellness of Nunavimmiut.

Qanuilirpitaa? 2017 is a population health survey carried out in Nunavik from August to October 2017. A total of 1 326 Nunavimmiut aged 16 and over from all 14 villages participated in this survey.
